


QUARTERLY REPORT

We wrapped up the five-month DreamRoot Leadership Accelerator with a Summit celebration, where 23 local Brazilian leaders came together in person to present their Life Canvas projects—a capstone they worked on throughout their leadership journey.

We engaged in **interactive games**, enjoyed a meal featuring Brazilian barbecue and feijoada (the national dish of Brazil), and introduced participants to **American snacks**, including s'mores. These moments sparked creativity, expanded horizons, and inspired **new visions of what's possible**.

We wrapped up a fantastic Brazil exchange trip, hosting participants from the U.S.! Together, we connected with locals, made new friends, and enjoyed the beautiful beaches and open markets. We shared celebrated delicious meals, Children's Day with a lively community block party, and some of us even trained in jiu jitsu.

At DreamRoot, our programs are designed to create experiences help people discover that themselves and others — building environments that encourage exploration, healing, and growth. Our goal is to bridge cultures, socioeconomic backgrounds, and industries, fostering intentional community that collaborates for collective impact and human flourishing, both locally and globally. This trip truly achieved that.



A highlight of the trip for the participants was training jiu jitsu with the kids at the Arte Suave DreamRoot Training Center and helping to host the Children's Day block party celebration.

One participant shared that what touched him most was how the center's programs and events like this were "giving the kids a childhood."

Additionally, several U.S. participants had the chance to teach and lead during jiu jitsu training sessions, where they put their BJJ leadership skills (and Portuguese!) to the test, offering their talents and contributing to the group.

Through our year-round gi drive, **63 jiu jitsu uniforms were donated** to BJJ students in need throughout Brazil.

Colin, an exchange trip participant, shared a memorable moment that came during a jiu jitsu training day when we invited a **13-year-old girl from a local orphanage** connected to the work of other DreamRoot leaders in different parts of the city.

She received one of the 63 donated gis that camp participants had brought from our gi drive, allowing her to join in the training.

On the mat that day were several other women and girls, who served as inspiring role models for her. With incredible courage and enthusiasm, she stepped onto the mats. Anyone who practices jiu jitsu knows how intimidating it can be to enter a new academy with unfamiliar training partners, but she embraced the experience with a smile, showing the strength and resilience of a true overcomer. Afterward, we all shared lunch, where she got to try cartola, a popular local dessert, for the first time.



Lifelong memories were made that day, shaping each of us in ways that will stay with us forever.
